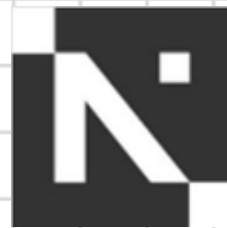

- Speaking, Listening and Communicating


Remote invigilation:
