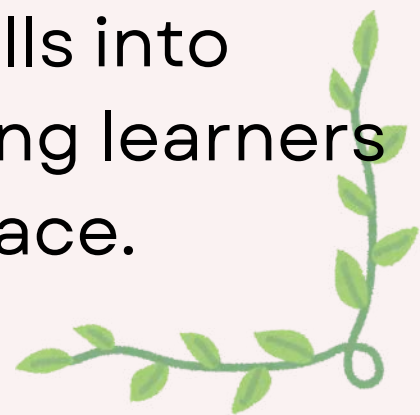
Compliance and Safeguarding Strengthened:

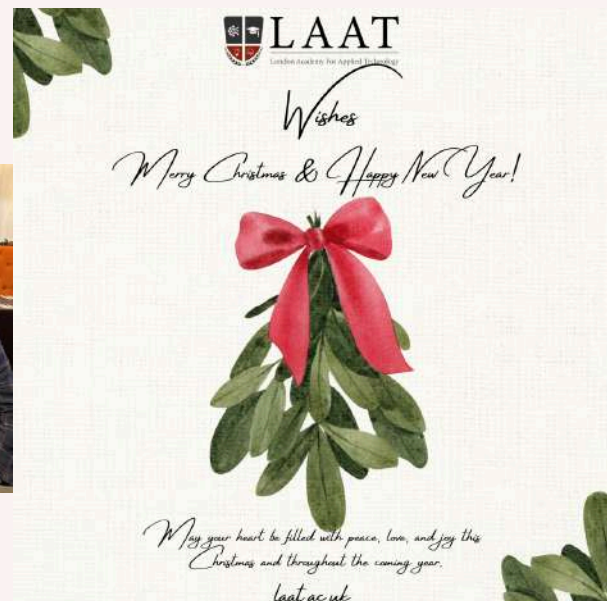
